I am looking forward to seeing you all in Seoul in coming October.

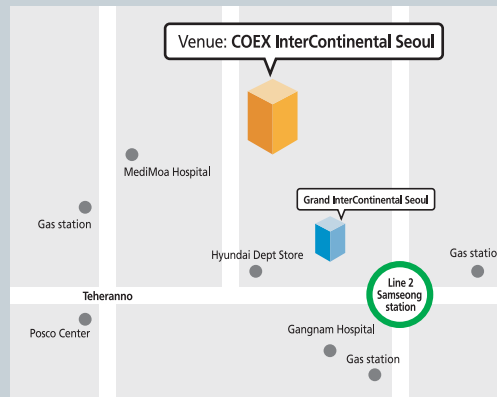
